

1. The Schools Division of Baguio City, in coordination with the Local Government Unit of Baguio City, announces that October 3 remain a non-working holiday for all school personnel citywide in celebration of Teachers' Day.

2. Pursuant to Baguio City Ordinance No. 05, s. 2023 and in collaboration with TESDA-CSITE, Private Schools/Institutions/Universities/Colleges, Philippine Science High School and Baguio City Local Government Unit, this Office likewise announces the conduct of Teachers' Day Summit, Wellness, and Sports Activities to celebrate the occasion.

3. Relative to this, a survey was launched in August 2025 to confirm participation of teachers or professors willing to join the stated activities. The survey yielded 1,538 confirmed participants from basic education (public/private), colleges, universities and institutions. Others shall enjoy the day on their own.

1. Punctuality and Participation

All school personnel who have confirmed their attendance are strongly encouraged to actively participate in the celebration and to arrive on time.

2. Wellness Service Stubs

Participants confirmed for October 3, 2025 will be issued a **Teachers' Day Wellness Service Stub** on a **first-come, first-served basis**, due to limited slots.

The following **services** will be offered:

- Therapeutic Body Massage – 300 slots
- Nail Aesthetic Services (Pedicure) – 40 slots
- Nail Aesthetic Services (Manicure) – 40 slots
- Professional Haircut Services – 40 slots

3. Schedule and Venue for Wellness Services

- The main celebration program will commence at 8:00 AM at the PFVR Gymnasium.
- Wellness services will be conducted from 11:00 AM to 12:00 NN, and will resume at 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM, to be held at the 3rd Floor Conference Hall, Schools Division Office of Baguio City.

4. Alternative Wellness Activity

A Tae Bo session will be held at the PFVR Gymnasium from 11:00 AM to 12:00 NN, and is open to all participants who are not accommodated in the above-mentioned wellness services.

5. Sports Activities and Venues (Afternoon Session)

Participants involved in sports activities in the afternoon will be assigned to the following venues:

- Basketball (3 teams) – Baguio SPED Center
- Volleyball (4 teams) – PFVR Gymnasium
- Chess – Baguio SPED Center
