

1. The Department of Education-Cordillera Administrative Region, through the Educational Support Services Division, will conduct the 2nd Regional Learners' Convergence (Regional LearnCon 2025) with the theme “**#GalingKabataan, Boses Mo, Bukas Natin**” on **November 17-21, 2025**, at Baguio Teachers Camp, Baguio City.

2. The activity is a face-to-face engagement of learners, youth leaders, and education stakeholders. 5. The chaperones shall act as the focal persons for their respective divisions and shall work closely with the learners by providing assistance in the completion and submission of the following requirements:

- a. signed SDO Pre-Registration Form
- b. signed Parental Consent and Waiver Form
- c. Medical Certificate issued by the Medical Officer or other duly authorized personnel; and
- d. scanned copy of:
 - d.1. school identification card for the learner-representatives; and
 - d.2. employee identification card for the chaperones.

6. The designated chaperones, after the completion of all required documents shall:

7. The Schools Division Offices shall ensure that all information submitted by the schools is completely and accurately reflected in the Division Pre-Registration Form, signed by the Schools Division Superintendent, as this will serve as the official and final list of participants.

8. The program includes a Multiple Intelligence activity to enhance teamwork, creativity, and learning application among the participants, followed by group presentations showcasing workshop outputs. Cash prizes will be awarded to the best-performing groups based on creativity, teamwork, and overall presentation, as follows:
