

**CONDUCT OF DISTRICT 2 and 10 MONITORING, EVALUATION  
and ADJUSTMENT**

1. In keeping with the Department's policy on systematic support and quality assurance, particularly under **DepEd Order No. 029, s. 2022** titled , Basic Education Monitoring and Evaluation Framework, or BEMEF, as well as DepEd's commitment to providing continuous technical assistance, the Curriculum and Implementation Division will conduct a technical assistance session for Districts 2 and 10 on **the 28<sup>th</sup> of November 2025 at 8:00 AM** at Fort del Pilar Elementary School and San Vicente Elementary School respectively.
2. The District MEA and LAC Session shall aim to accomplish the following:
  - a. Present the 2nd Quarter SMEA results for review, monitoring, and necessary adjustments;
  - b. Examine the underlying factors influencing the Quarter 2 assessment outcomes and performance data, and determine appropriate intervention measures;
  - c. Highlight successful strategies and initiatives that enhance learner achievement and support the effective implementation of PPAs;
  - d. Track the progress of the ARAL Programs for adjustments; and
  - e. Deliver relevant and timely technical assistance through LAC Session, Information Sharing, Group and Work Management.
3. Participants in the DisMEA are 6 School Heads of District 2 and 7 School Heads of District 10.
4. Participants are expected to prepare their presentations as a result of school-based monitoring and discussions. They are also to assign Officer-in-Charge in their respective schools as they attend the said activity.
