

CHANGE THE CURRENT 3.0 SCHOOL-LED CLIMATE GOVERNANCE

1. In relation to the invitation and partnership of the Save Philippine Seas on the conduct of Change the Current (CTC) 3.0 School-led Climate Governance: a training program promoting adolescent empowerment and civic engagement through participatory and meaningful community-based climate action, this office informs the field that the activity will be on **January 8-12, 2025** at the **3rd Floor Training Hall, SDO Baguio City.** (*Enclosure 1. Dear Dr. Faculo,


We are deeply grateful for your support, particularly during the recently concluded focus group discussions and key informant interviews conducted in preparation for *Change the Current 3.0 (CTC 3.0) - School-led Climate Governance* workshops.

CTC 3.0, implemented with the support of UNICEF Philippines and the Department of Education's Youth Formation Division (DepEd-YFD), aims to (i) enhance the capacity of student governments and other school-based organizations to contribute to school-level programs that promote climate-smart education, and (ii) strengthen the community of practice on climate education and action within the Schools Division Offices.

For its second year of implementation, we aim to train 60 student leaders from the Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSLG) and the Youth for Environment in Schools Organization (YES-O), along with 30 teacher-advisers in Baguio City.

In this regard, we would like to express our intent to conduct the CTC 3.0 in Baguio City on *January 8-12, 2026*. The proposed schedule is as follows:

Dates	Workshop	Participants
January 8 - 10 (3 Days)	Student Track	Four (4) students per school: two from SSLG and two from YES-O, from 15 different schools
January 11 - 12 (2 Days)	Teacher Track	Two (2) advisers per school: one from SSLG and one from YES-O from the same schools
Total:		60 student-participants and 30 teacher-advisers



We respectfully seek your approval to hold this activity and to coordinate with your office regarding the participation of selected students and teachers in your division.
