

 - d. Empower the NextGen Leaders become more effective, resilient, and autonomous agents of discovery and impact.

This activity is in support of the continuous professional development of future school leaders, as encouraged by the Enhanced Career Progression in DepEd Order 24, s. 2025, and with the commitment of the Department to fostering school improvement, enhancing teaching quality, and driving student success.
