

1. To strengthen the implementation of the TLE, Tech-Voc/TechPro, and Transition Program curriculum, this training aims to capacitate teachers in delivering competency-based and industry-aligned instruction. It will equip teachers with essential knowledge, skills, and competencies aligned with TESDA Training Regulations and DepEd's curriculum standards.
2. The training on Food and Beverage Services (FBS) NC II and Bread and Pastry Production (BPP) NC II will commence on **February 18, 2026 (8:00AM)**, at Data Center College of the Philippines, Bonifacio Street, Baguio City.
3. The succeeding training sessions and assessment schedules will be announced during the orientation to ensure that all participants receive the complete timeline and necessary reminders for the duration of the training.
4. This training aims to:
  - a. Equip TechPro and Transition teachers with industry-standard competencies;
  - b. Prepare teachers for TESDA National Certificate (NC II) assessment;
  - c. Strengthen teachers' capacity to deliver competency-based and curriculum-aligned instruction;
  - d. Support effective implementation of TVL and Transition Programs in basic education.
5. Interested TLE/TechPro teachers and SNED transition teachers shall register on or before February 14, 2026, due to training capacity limitations, late registrants may not be accommodated, using the link below:
