

Its focus is primarily on the mastery of competencies required to land a noble and prolific career in journalism. Admission is open to all incoming Grade 7 learners who exhibit talent in journalism based on the results of the qualifying examinations and interview to be conducted by the school screening committee.

- a. Duly accomplished application form

- b. Two (2) latest 2" x 2" picture with name tag, white background
- c. Photocopy of Grade 6 Report Card duly certified correct by the Elementary Principal
OR bring the original copy of Report Card together with a photocopy to be certified by the BCHS Guidance Counselor

Grade requirement

Final General Average should be 85% or higher
Final Rating in English should be 85% or higher
Final Rating in Filipino should be 85% or higher

- d. Photocopy of certificates of recognition for applicants who have participated and won in previous school, division, regional or national schools press conferences (*if available*)
 - e. Two Hundred Fifty Pesos examination fee for transportation and representation expenses
3. The application period runs from **April 01, 2026 to May 06, 2026**. The examination and screening will take place on **May 08, 2026 at 8:00 AM at Grade 8-Consistency**.
