

1. This is to inform all concerned that the Teachers' Dignity Coalition (TDC) will conduct its National Seminar-Workshop on Education Policy, Advocacy, and Legal Protection for Teachers on February 27 to March 1, 2026, at the Great Eastern Hotel, Quezon City.
2. The activity aims to review current national policies affecting teachers' and learners' welfare, discuss prevailing education issues, solicit ideas for reform, empower teachers and administrators with essential legal knowledge and skills, and develop policy recommendations to address challenges faced by teachers and learners.
3. Teachers who wish to participate may opt to attend the said activity on Official Business, subject to the following conditions:
  - a. Compliance with the applicable provisions of DepEd Order No. 046, s. 2022, titled Amendment to DepEd Order No. 043, s. 2022 (Omnibus Travel Guidelines for All Personnel of the Department of Education), and other appropriate travel-related orders and guidelines.
  - b. Approval from the School Heads concerned.
  - c. Participation shall not interfere with the regular functions and responsibilities of the teachers; and
  - d. Expenses of the participants shall be charged against local funds, subject to availability and in accordance with existing budgeting, accounting, and auditing rules and regulations.
4. Teachers concerned are advised to make the necessary coordination with their school heads to ensure that classes and other official duties will not be disrupted.

The Teachers' Dignity Coalition (TDC) will hold the **National Seminar-Workshop on Education Policy Advocacy and Legal Protection for Teachers on February 27 to March 1, 2026**, at the **Great Eastern Hotel, Quezon City**. With the theme **"Empowering Teachers Through Enhanced Legal Rights Education,"** the activity is aligned with the Department's efforts to strengthen teacher protection and promote their welfare.

This seminar will be attended by teacher-leaders, administrators and other education workers from across the country. The activity aims to help elevate teachers' morale and productivity by fostering a more supportive and conducive working environment.

The specific objectives of the event are as follows:

- Review the current national policies affecting teachers' and students' welfare;

- Develop policy recommendations to address challenges faced by teachers/learners.

Each participant will be charged a **minimal registration fee of Five Thousand Two Hundred Pesos (₱5,200.00)** to cover expenses for board and lodging, training materials, speakers' honoraria, and other incidental costs. Registration and billeting will begin at 1:00 PM on February 27, while check-out time will be at 12:00 NN on March 1.

In this regard, we respectfully request your office to endorse this activity to the respective Schools Division Superintendents, allowing the official participation of delegates. We likewise request that registration and transportation expenses be sourced from local funds, including MOOE, LGU, or any other available funds.

*To regulate the number of participants, TDC will submit a list of confirmed attendees to the concerned regional and division offices on the first week of February. Participants who are not included in the list may still be accommodated if slots are available, provided they coordinate with the Secretariat ahead of the schedule. The deadline for confirmation and pre-registration is January 30, 2026 (Friday), to allow sufficient time for preparations.*




