



## REGIONAL OFFICE MEMORANDUM No. 03 s.2026

TO : **COUNCIL SCOUT EXECUTIVES/ OFFICERS-IN-CHARGE**

SUBJECT : **2026 REGIONAL SCOUT YOUTH FORUM (RSYF)**


1. As part of the 2026 Regional BSP Calendar of Scouting Events and Observances, please be informed of the conduct of the **2026 REGIONAL SCOUT YOUTH FORUM (RSYF)** on **11-13 MARCH 2026** at **2F DepEd SDO Cauayan Function Hall, Turayong, Cauayan City, Isabela** to be hosted by **BSP, Cauayan City Associate Council**.
2. The primary purpose of this forum is for Scouts to discuss important topics related to their current needs, interests, and concerns as well as to express and share their ideas and solutions to the topic being presented and deliberated following the parliamentary rules and procedures. Furthermore, there will be an election of two (2) Regional Scout Representatives who will sit as mandated members of the Regional Scout Committee (RESCOM) and will be joined by other elected Scouts to compose the six (6) Official Voting Delegates and represent the Northeastern Luzon Region in the 2026 National Scout Youth Forum in San Antonio Resort, Roxas City, Province of Capiz on 14-17 April 2026.
3. Qualifications:
  - a) Must be a currently registered Senior Scout.
  - b) Must be within 14-18 years of age as patterned in the advancement guidelines for the Senior Scouting Section.
  - c) Official Voting Delegates/Scout Representatives must be within 14-18 years of age upon the time of election as they will be serving a term of one (1) year and it will maintain them as valid members of the Senior Scouting Section, and must have been elected in the prior levels of the Scout Youth Forum.
  - d) Must at least hold the Outdoorsman/Outdoors Scout Rank, a minimum rank for the delegates because of their prior experience and knowledge in Scouting that can help them in the creation of resolutions.

Each Local Council is entitled to send **THREE (3) OFFICIAL VOTING DELEGATES** and at least **TWO (2) OBSERVERS**. Local Council may opt to send additional observers.

4. A Registration Fee of **ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P 1,000.00)** will be charged from each **forum participant (official voting delegates and observers)** and accompanying **Outfit Advisors/ Scout leaders**, to defray expenses for meals and snacks (from Lunch of 11 March 2026 until Lunch of 13 March 2026). Participants and accompanying Scout Leaders will be billeted separately on the adjacent schools. Registration fee shall be remitted to the host council on or before **04 March 2026** to facilitate the preparation of the host. 5. Opening program will start at exactly 1300H of 11 March 2026. Forum participants and Accompanying Adults are required to bring their own sleeping gears and other personal necessities. Additionally, Scouts should also bring their Type "A" Scout uniform, smart casual attire, and a scout neckerchief which shall be worn at all times.
6. Prior to the participation to the Regional Scout Youth Forum, all Local Councils shall conduct their respective Council Scout Youth Forum not only to determine participants to the RSYF, but importantly, to elect Scout Representatives as mandated members of the Local Council Executive Board that shall serve as the voice of young people.
7. In compliance to the BSP National Safeguarding Policy, all participants are required to accomplish the Annex B: Consent and Assent Form (*see BSP National Office Memorandum No. 08, s.2025*) and for the Accompanying Adult, the WOSM Safe From Harm certificate. Furthermore, CSEs/OICs are advised to facilitate the official release and travel itineraries of their respective delegates.
8. Since the six (6) Official Voting Delegates of the region to the 2026 NSYF will be free of charge from air/land/sea fares, inland transportation, meals, souvenirs, and accommodation, kindly ensure that a Scout is allowed to travel and attend the 2026 NSYF at Roxas City, Capiz once elected.
