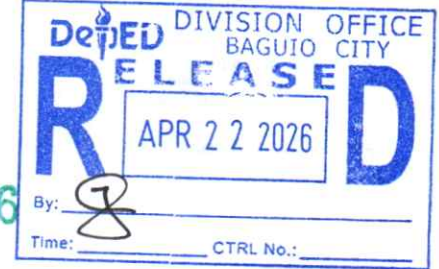

The Benguet State University – College of Education-Advanced Studies through letter addressed to the Office of the Schools Division Superintendent dated April 20, 2026 informs Instructional Leaders on the Implementation of Project DAP-AY: A 2 -Day Professional Development Program for Emergent School-Based Instructional Leaders to be conducted on **May 8-9, 2026 via Zoom.**

The program aims to strengthen competencies in instructional leadership, digital pedagogy, data informed decision making and learner support systems aligned with the PPST.

The training is structured into two phases as follows:

Phase 1: DAP-AY DATA (Data Analysis for teaching and Action in Instructional Leadership which focuses on strengthening participants' capacity to analyze school-based issues and improve instructional practices through evidenced based approaches.

Phase 2: DAP-AY CARE (Coordination and Administrative Response for Education in School Leadership) This phase emphasizes appropriate school-based responses to learner concerns and the strengthening of support systems.

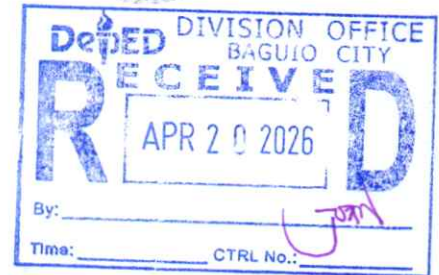

The Benguet State University – College of Teacher Education, through its Advanced Studies, respectfully seeks the endorsement of the Schools Division Office of Baguio for the implementation of Project DAP-AY: A 2-Day Professional Development Program for Emergent School-Based Instructional Leaders, to be conducted on **May 8–9, 2026, via Zoom.**

The program is designed for emergent school-based instructional leaders which are Teacher I-VII and Master Teachers I-V. The program aims to strengthen competencies in instructional leadership, digital pedagogy, data-informed decision-making, and learner support systems, aligned with the Philippine Professional Standards for Teachers (PPST), Philippine Professional Standards for School Heads (PPSH), and Philippine Professional Standards for Supervisors (PPSS).

The training is structured into two phases:

Phase 1: DAP-AY DATA (Data Analysis for Teaching and Action in Instructional Leadership)

This phase focuses on strengthening participants' capacity to analyze school-based issues and improve instructional practices through evidence-based approaches. It includes the following sessions:

- Session 1: Instructional Leadership for Learning Recovery and Foundational Competencies
- Session 2: Digital Pedagogy, AI Literacy, and Ethics in the Modern Classroom
- Session 3: Data Analytics for School Improvement and Educational Research

Phase 2: DAP-AY CARE (Coordination and Administrative Response for Education in School Leadership)

This phase emphasizes appropriate school-based responses to learner concerns and the strengthening of support systems. It includes:

- Session 4: Handling Sensitive Cases and Proper Referral Procedures

The program culminates in a Workshop on Research-Based Action Planning, where participants will develop a Workplace Action Plan grounded in their school context. This


