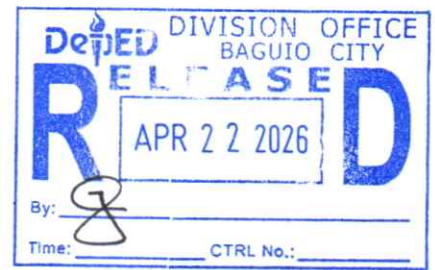

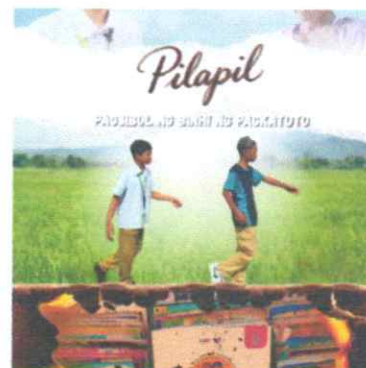

**SUBMISSION OF ACADEMIC RECOVERY AND ACCESSIBLE LEARNING (ARAL)
PROGRAM ACCOMPLISHMENT REPORT AND SUCCESS STORIES**

1. Relative to the Department of Education's continuous efforts to monitor and evaluate the Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning (ARAL) Program, this is to inform the field that all schools/implementers are required to submit their ARAL program data for division and regional consolidation.
2. The needed information shall comprehensively capture the implementation of the ARAL program hence, School heads/Principals must ensure that submissions are accurate, complete, and properly validated to support effective division and regional reporting. The following are the details:
 - a. MOSY, EOSY data, Number of ARAL learners and volunteers;
 - b. Duration (frequency, number of minutes/hours per session, schedule such as weekdays/weekends);
 - c. Scheme/Delivery modes (add-on, embedded within regular classes, pull-out sessions);
 - d. LSEN/SNED learners (not yet assessed but with manifestation of reading disability);
 - e. Gadgets used for ARAL tutorials (tablets, laptops, PC etc.);
 - f. Gains/Best practices, Learners who exited the ARAL program, Partnerships and Community engagement;
 - g. Unresolved issues/Challenges, Opportunities and Recommendations, and
 - h. Cause/s on low performance or reasons why there are still ARAL learners.

- You can also add specific ARAL success stories/narratives, featuring learners who improved under the ARAL Program, teachers who served as tutors, parents' testimonials, among others
- You may also include links to videos/reels and other multimedia content featuring ARAL narratives/kwentong ARAL

School Heads/Principals are also advised to coordinate with their respective PSDSs for the link of Google sheets to be filled out on or before May 6, 2026. Kindly send success stories and the link for videos etc. if applicable to the division ARAL focal person through this email address (armi.fiangaan@deped.gov.ph). Please be guided accordingly.
