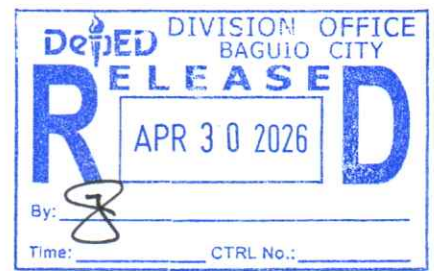

CONDUCT OF ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM (ALS) LITERACY MAPPING AND ENROLLMENT FOR SY 2026-2027

1. Pursuant to the advocacy and social mobilization efforts of the Alternative Learning System. ALS implementers will conduct literacy mapping and enrollment in selected barangays of Baguio City from May 4 to June 3, 2026.
2. The activity aims to:
 - a. promote inclusive access to quality alternative education for all learners, particularly those in underserved communities, by providing comprehensive, flexible, and adequate learning opportunities outside the formal school system; and
 - b. identify the number of Out-of-School Children, Youths, and Adults (OSCYAs) who need basic literacy and education.
3. All ALS implementers are instructed to participate actively in these activities. Upon completion of the mapping and enrollment period, accomplishment report must be submitted to the ALS Office for evaluation.
4. Participants in the literacy mapping and enrollment shall be granted service credits or compensatory overtime credits (COC).
5. To ensure a coordinated rollout, a preparatory meeting will be held on May 4, 2026, 1:30 PM at the ALS Office, Military Cut-off, Baguio City, with the participation of 18 ALS Teachers, 2 EPSAs, and the CID Chief.
6. Immediate dissemination and strict compliance of this Memorandum is desired.
