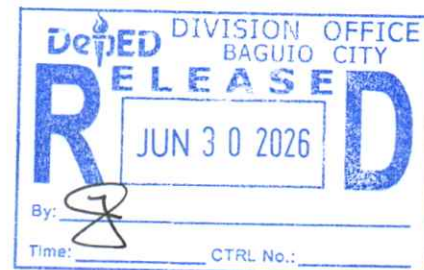

In line with the request of Saint Louis University, in partnership with the Catholic Educational Association of the Philippines (CEAP) and the Diocese of Baguio, this Office disseminates information on the conduct of the educational forum entitled "**DAPAT ISA LANG.**"

The forum aims to provide participants with a deeper understanding of civic engagement, democratic participation, and the role of citizens in nation-building through discussions on political participation and governance. It also seeks to promote awareness of the People's Initiative advocating for the passage of a genuine anti-political dynasty law in the Philippines.

The activity will be conducted on **July 10, 2026 (Friday)** at **Saint Louis University**, with the following session schedules:

- **9:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m.**
- **1:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m.**

The organizers are inviting selected Senior High School students from Catholic schools in Baguio City to participate in the forum alongside college students. The activity is aligned with the Senior High School curriculum, particularly the learning competencies on citizenship, democratic values, civic participation, and nation-building.

Participation in the activity shall be voluntary and subject to the approval of the respective school heads and the written consent of the parents or guardians of the participating learners. Schools shall ensure that participation complies with existing DepEd policies on the conduct of off-campus activities and the non-disruption of classes as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005, Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith. Any expenses relative to participation shall be borne on a personal basis.


II. Learning Competencies (Mga Kasanayan)
