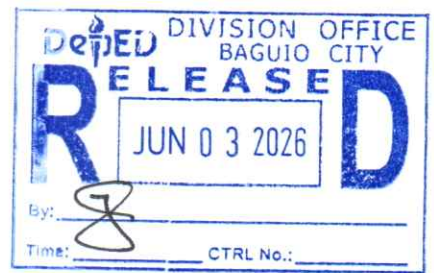

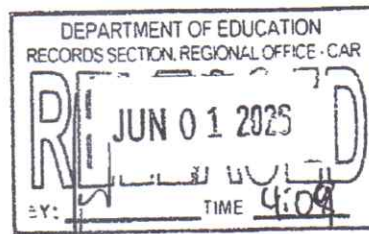

The Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) is currently conducting an assessment of the pilot implementation of the Alternative Learning System Senior High School (ALS-SHS) Program. This initiative is anchored on the mandate of Republic Act No. 11510, which institutionalizes ALS as a parallel pathway for out-of-school youth, children in special cases, and adults and is further guided by DepEd Order No. 1, s. 2026 or the *Implementing Guidelines of the Enhanced Alternative Learning System*.

By gathering feedback from ALS implementers regarding the pilot phase, BAE seeks to utilize these insights to inform the review and development of ALS SHS Curriculum aligned with the Strengthened Senior High School Curriculum. Ultimately, this evaluation ensures that the curriculum remains responsive, relevant, and fully aligned with national standards to better serve the needs of diverse ALS learners.
