ENSURING SAFETY OF LEARNERS AND PERSONNEL IN SCHOOLS

To: Chief Education Supervisors
Public Schools District Supervisor
Public School Heads
All Other Concerned

1. In compliance with the **Regional Memorandum No. 429, s. 2026** dated June 9, 2026, regarding measures to ensure safety amid the rainy season and recent seismic activities across the country. All schools and offices in the Schools Division of Baguio City are hereby directed to undertake the following:

- Conduct risk and vulnerability assessments of school facilities and grounds, and implement immediate corrective actions for identified hazards.
- Review, update, and test Emergency Response, Evacuation, and Contingency Plans for heavy rains, flooding, tropical cyclones, and earthquakes.
- Strategically pre-position, safely store, and inventory Edukahon Self-Learning Kits, modules, and other learning materials, ready for immediate distribution once face-to-face classes are suspended.
- Strictly observe provisions of DepEd Order No. 33, s. 2021 (School-Based Disaster Preparedness and Response) and DepEd Order No. 27, s. 2015 (Family Earthquake Preparedness), including the enclosed detailed safety protocols before, during, and after an earthquake.

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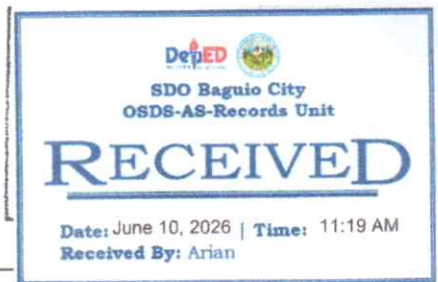

ENSURING SAFETY OF LEARNERS AND PERSONNEL IN SCHOOLS

To: Assistant Regional Director
Schools Division Superintendents
Public and Private Elementary and Secondary School Heads
All Others Concerned

1. The start of the rainy season coupled by the series of earthquakes being experienced across the country significantly increases the threat on the safety of our schools, learners, and personnel.
2. To ensure safety within school and office premises, this Office directs all DepEd offices and schools to take proactive steps to mitigate risks and ensure absolute readiness, including but not limited to the conduct of risk assessments, implementation of safety measures, review and updating of emergency response plans.
3. Likewise, it is strictly advised that *Edukahon* self-learning kits, modules and other teaching and learning materials be strategically prepositioned in schools, safely stored and ready for immediate deployment once face-to-face classes are suspended.
4. This Office further reiterates strict compliance to DepEd Order No. 33, s. 2021(School-Based Disaster Preparedness and Response Measures for Tropical Cyclones, Flooding, and Other Weather-Related Disturbances and Calamities and DepEd Order No. 27, s. 2015 (Promoting Family Earthquake Preparedness). To strengthen Earthquake preparedness, the specific safety protocols to be observed before, during, and after an earthquake are enclosed.
5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is earnestly desired.
