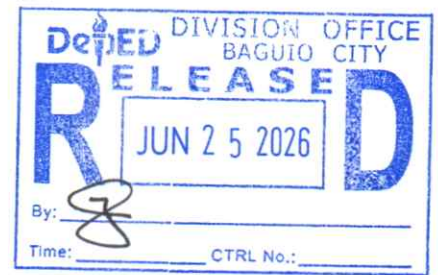

1. This Office informs all concerned that the request regarding the conduct of the Training on Urban Aquaculture and Fisheries has been approved. This initiative aims to equip teachers with essential technical knowledge to effectively deliver curriculum-aligned aquaculture lessons and guide learners in practical and community-based applications. This activity is being conducted in partnership with the City Veterinary and Agriculture Office (CVAO) and the Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR).
2. The training will be conducted on June 27, 2026 (Saturday) 8:00AM to 5:00PM at Tugos Hotel, Naguilian Road, Baguio City. The schedule has been set on a Saturday in compliance with the DepEd Memorandum on non-disruption of classroom instruction.
3. This training is competency-based, focusing on the raising, rearing, and harvesting of fish, ensuring that participants gain practical skills and hands-on knowledge that can be directly applied in teaching aquaculture and supporting school and community-based initiatives.
4. Participants to this activity are Grade 6 TLE teachers (one per school) from all public elementary schools. (see attached enclosure)
5. School Heads are requested to facilitate the dissemination of this memorandum and ensure the attendance of identified participants.
