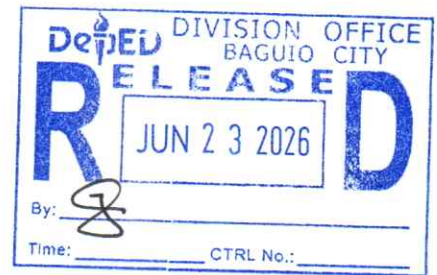

CONDUCT OF LAC SESSION ON PROJECT L.I.G.H.T. AND PRESENTATION OF THE 2026 GAWAD CORDILLERA GUIDELINES

In support of the Department of Education's commitment to improving key performance indicators through responsive and quality educational services, and in line with Project Mountain View of DepEd-CAR as stipulated in Regional Memorandum No. 388, s. 2026, all District 2 Public School Heads and Master Teachers are invited to attend the LAC Session on **Project L.I.G.H.T. (Leading Instructional Growth through Holistic Transformation)** and the **Presentation of the 2026 Gawad Cordillera Guidelines** on **June 24, 2026, 3:00 PM onwards, at Fort Del Pilar Elementary School.**

Project L.I.G.H.T. is a district instructional supervision framework that promotes data-driven leadership, instructional improvement, coaching, and continuous technical assistance to enhance teaching quality and learner outcomes. This was presented during the Philippine Schools District Supervisors Conference held in Cagayan de Oro City on February 10-12, 2026 which highlighted improved data management, instructional monitoring, and school governance through digital solutions.
3. Specifically, the session aims to:
 - a. Strengthen progressive instructional supervision through the effective use of data analytics and instructional monitoring tools;
 - b. Review and enhance the utilization of the Classroom Observation Lab, Awards System, and the **Dalyasat Ni Adal**, a district data management platform/ mini website platform for ready references;
 - c. Ensure the integration, supervision and monitoring of learners and teachers' well-being and resiliency;
 - e. Implement Green Economy in the school level through effective planning and monitoring; and
 - f. Implement the GAWAD Cordillera Guidelines
