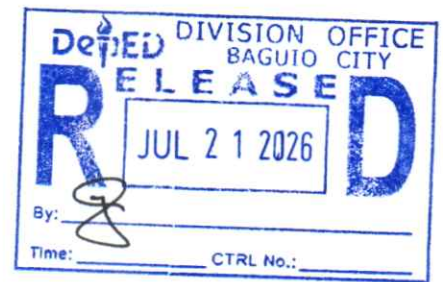

ADOPTION AND SUBMISSION OF THE HARMONIZED SCHOOL LEARNING AND SERVICE CONTINUITY PLAN (LSCP) FOR EDUCATION IN EMERGENCIES (EIE)

To: Chief ES, Curriculum Implementation Division

Others concerned

1. In view of the implementation of DepEd Order No. 22, s. 2024, Revised Guidelines on Class and Work Suspension in Schools During Disasters and Emergencies, and DepEd Order No. 14, s. 2026, Policy Guidelines on Learning Continuity During Emergencies, all public elementary and secondary schools are hereby directed to accomplish the School Learning and Service Continuity Plan (LSCP) for Education in Emergencies (EiE) using the standardized Division template.
2. The Division recognizes that the standardized LSCP template is a working document and may be refined based on implementation, policy updates, and feedback from schools.
3. Accordingly, all School Heads, including those who have previously submitted their LSCPs, are requested to re-accomplish and resubmit their plans through the prescribed online form, which may be accessed through the following link:

4. Print copy in A4 size placed in a folder shall be submitted to the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) Focal Person a week after the due date and once reviewed by their respective PSDS.
5. The online submission shall serve as the official repository of schools' LSCPs to facilitate efficient consolidation, monitoring, updating, and provision of technical assistance by the Schools Division Office.
6. In accordance with DepEd Order No. 14, s. 2026, School Heads are likewise reminded that the LSCP shall be reviewed and updated at the end of every school term, or as necessary, to ensure that it remains responsive to the school's current context,



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emerging risks, available resources, and appropriate continuity strategies for learning and school operations.

7. All School Heads are enjoined to accomplish the online LSCP on or before July 24, 2026.
8. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
