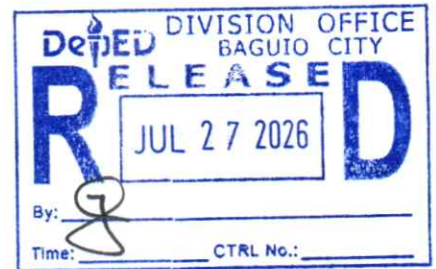

**CONDUCT OF RESPONSIVE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE ON THE
IMPLEMENTATION OF THE LEARNING SYSTEMS REFORM POLICIES**

1.
