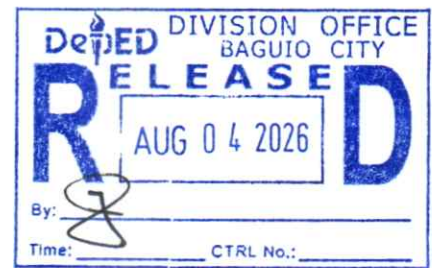

**FLEXIBLE LEARNING PROGRAM UPDATES AND ORIENTATION TO SCHOOLS
WITH PREMIUM ON SCHOOL-INITIATED INTERVENTION PROGRAMS**

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 14, s. 2026 or the *Guidelines on Learning Continuity in Emergencies* and the recent Regional Memorandum No. 525, s. 2026 on the implementation of Learning Continuity in Emergencies and the draft policy guidelines on Flexible Learning Programs (FLPs), the Schools Division Office of Baguio City shall conduct a two-day **FLP Updates and Orientation to Schools with Premium on School-Initiated Intervention Programs (SIIPs)**
2. The activity seeks to strengthen the understanding of school leaders and supervisors on the implementation of Flexible Learning Programs and Learning Continuity in Emergencies, while highlighting school-based interventions that address learners' diverse needs and learning gaps.
3. Specifically, the activity aims to:
 - a. Provide updates on current policies and directions on Flexible Learning Programs (FLPs);
 - b. Orient participants on Learning Continuity in Emergencies and its implications for school implementation;
 - c. Reinforce the role of School-Initiated Intervention Programs in improving learner participation, retention, and achievement;
 - d. Share promising practices and intervention strategies implemented by schools; and
 - e. Develop action plans for the effective implementation, monitoring, and evaluation of Flexible Learning Programs and intervention initiatives.
