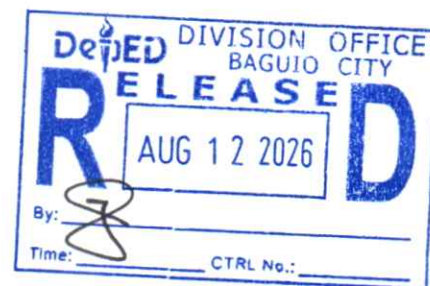

**CONFIRMATION OF PARTICIPANTS FOR THE WRITINGWORKSHOP ON
STRENGTHENING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF BASIC HUMAN RIGHTS AND
INDIGENOUS PEOPLES' RIGHTS IN SCHOOLS**

1. Pursuant to Baguio City Resolution Number 073 (Series of 2026), which urges the Department of Education-Schools Division Office (SDO) of Baguio City, in coordination with the National Commission on Indigenous Peoples-Cordillera Administrative Region (NCIP-CAR), to develop and implement a short course or modular program on basic human rights and indigenous peoples' rights for roll-out during the National Human Rights Consciousness Week from December 4 to 10, starting this 2026, the SDO-Baguio City, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), will conduct a writing workshop entitled "Strengthening the Implementation of Basic Human Rights and Indigenous Peoples' Rights in Schools" on September 3, 8-10, 19, and 25, 2026, at a venue to be identified in Baguio City.
2. The objectives of this activity are the following:
 - a. Map learning competencies in all learning areas where basic human rights and indigenous peoples' rights can be integrated;
 - b. Develop learning resources particularly modular programs on basic human rights and indigenous peoples' rights that will foster creativity in learners, which can stimulate imaginative thinking and problem-solving skills through engaging and interactive tasks;
 - c. Quality assure and finalize the LR's on basic human rights and indigenous peoples' rights;
 - d. Launch the developed LR's on basic human rights and indigenous peoples' rights, and
