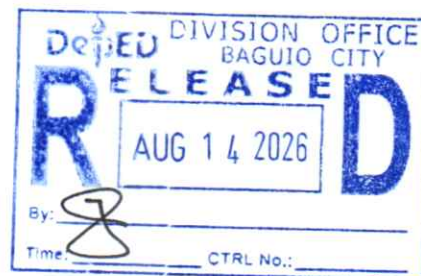

**SUBMISSION OF QUALIFIED LEARNERS FOR THE EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE
FROM THE CITY SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT OFFICE (CSWDO)**

1. One of the flagship programs of the City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) is the Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS), which includes the provision of educational assistance to qualified learners. This initiative aims to help lessen the financial burden of low-income households by providing support for educational expenses such as school supplies, uniforms, hygiene kits, and other school-related needs of enrolled children. Through this program, our partner agency hopes to encourage learners to continue their education and improve their academic performance.
2. Relative to this, all schools are requested to submit the names of learners who come from low-income and financially challenged families and who are not beneficiaries of other government assistance programs such as 4Ps and the Gawad Lingap Program, with 1,000 elementary and 1,000 secondary learners to be identified.
3. In the interest of fairness and equitable distribution of the number of learners per level, a ratio and proportion were used. The number of learners per school is presented in the table below.
