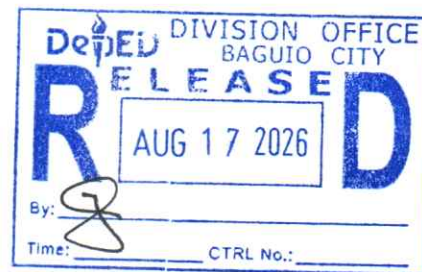

**SUBMISSION OF CATCH-UP PLANS TO ADDRESS LEARNING LOSS DUE TO
TYPHOON-RELATED CLASS SUSPENSIONS**

To : Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
Chief Education Supervisors
Education Program Supervisors
Public Schools District Supervisors

1. In view of the recurring class suspensions brought about by typhoons and other weather disturbances, all Public Schools District Supervisors are directed to prepare a catch plan focusing on analyzing the impact of lost instructional time on learner performance and the corresponding interventions to address learning loss.
2. Apart from reporting the number of class suspension days per school and per month, District Supervisors shall conduct an analysis of the academic performance of learners to determine the extent to which lost instructional time has affected learning outcomes. Particular attention shall be given to:
 - a. District learners' performance in 1st term summative assessments and other learning assessments across subject areas and grades;
 - b. Learner attendance, engagement, and completion of learning tasks;
 - c. Number and profile of learners identified as at risk of falling behind academically including those affected by the landslide; and
 - d. Gaps in learning that require immediate catch-up interventions.
3. District Supervisors shall recommend catch-up strategies and monitoring mechanisms to ensure that affected learners regain lost learning opportunities and attain the expected learning standards.
