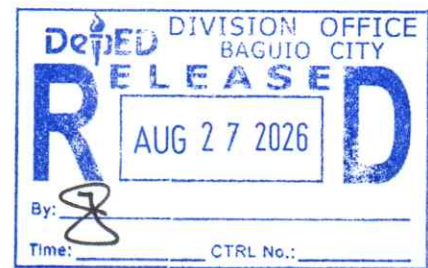

**DOWNLOADING OF FUNDS TO SCHOOLS IN SUPPORT OF THE FLEXIBLE
LEARNING PROGRAM (ALTERNATIVE DELIVERY MODE) ON SCHOOL-
INITIATED INTERVENTION (SII) FOR LEARNERS
AT RISK OF DROPPING OUT**

1. Pursuant to the provisions of the Alternative Delivery Mode (ADM) Program under the Flexible Learning Options (FLO) and in support of School-Initiated Intervention (SII) for learners at risk of dropping out, this Office announces the downloading of funds to identified schools to strengthen interventions and educational support mechanisms that will ensure learner retention, participation, and completion of basic education.
2. School-Initiated Intervention (SII) is one of the strategic components of the Dropout Reduction Program designed by schools to address specific dropout-related concerns unique to their learners. The downloaded funds shall be utilized to implement activities and interventions that promote learner engagement, continuous participation, and academic success.
3. The following schools are recipients of the FLP (ADM) - SII Program Support Fund amounting to Nineteen Thousand Pesos (₱19,000.00) each to support the implementation of School-Initiated Intervention (SII) programs for learners at risk of dropping out:

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This fund shall be utilized solely for allowable activities and expenses related to the implementation of the Alternative Delivery Mode through School-Initiated Intervention (FLP (ADM)-SII) in accordance with existing DepEd policies and guidelines.

4. The program support fund may be used for eligible activities related to School-Initiated Interventions, including but not limited to:
 - Development and implementation of school-based intervention programs;
 - Monitoring and evaluation of ADM and SII implementation;
 - Conduct of learner support activities and related ADM initiatives; and
 - Other allowable expenses directly related to the implementation of approved FLP (ADM)-SII activities.
5. The downloaded funds shall not be used for the purchase of capital outlay items, subscriptions, internet services, cable television services, employment of contractual personnel, or other expenditures prohibited under existing government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. Recipient schools shall prepare and submit their Project Procurement Management Plan (PPMP) and School Operating Budget (SOB), relative to the implementation of their School-Initiated Intervention program on or **before September 15, 2026**.
7. School Heads shall ensure the proper, efficient, and transparent utilization of the downloaded funds and shall submit the required financial and accomplishment reports in accordance with applicable accounting, auditing, monitoring, and reporting guidelines.
8. The Curriculum Implementation Division through the Division FLP Focal Person shall provide technical assistance and monitor the implementation of the interventions to ensure that the objectives of the FLP – SII are achieved.
9. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum is desired.
