PLANNING ACTIVITY ON STRENGTHENING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF BASIC HUMAN RIGHTS AND INDIGENOUS PEOPLES' RIGHTS IN THE SCHOOL THROUGH THE DEVELOPMENT, FINALIZATION AND QUALITY ASSURANCE OF LEARNING RESOURCES ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF BASIC HUMAN RIGHTS AND INDIGENOUS PEOPLES' RIGHTS

1. Pursuant to Division Memorandum No. 513, s. 2026, the Schools Division Office of Baguio City, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), will conduct a planning activity on **September 3, 2026, at 8:30 AM** at the Ecolodge Hotel, Health 100, Magsaysay Avenue, Baguio City. This activity serves as preparation for the writing workshop on "Strengthening the Implementation of Basic Human Rights and Indigenous Peoples' Rights in Schools," which will be held on September 8–10, and 19, 2026.

2. The activity aims to achieve the following objectives:

- a. Shared Understanding. Participants will demonstrate a shared understanding of the project's rationale, scope, and expected outputs, as well as of relevant DepEd policies, human rights principles, and the Indigenous Peoples Education (IPEd) framework.
- b. Mapped Competencies. Produce a consolidated matrix mapping learning competencies across all learning areas (K–12) where basic human rights and IP rights can be integrated, identifying priority grade levels and subject areas for learning resource development.
- c. Organized Teams. Organize teams for the development and quality assurance of learning resources, with roles, responsibilities, and deliverables assigned to each member and documented in a team matrix.
- d. Standardized templates and QA criteria. participants will have agreed on the LR templates, formats, and quality assurance standards—including cultural sensitivity and IP representation guidelines—and these will be distributed to all writers and validators.
