1. Pursuant to Baguio City Resolution Numbered 073 (Series of 2026), urging the Department of Education-Schools Division Office (SDO) of Baguio City in coordination with the National Commission on Indigenous Peoples-Cordillera Administrative Region (NCIP-CAR) to develop and implement a short course or modular program on basic human rights and indigenous peoples' rights for roll-out during the national human rights consciousness week from December 4 to 10 starting this 2026, the Schools Division Office of Baguio City, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), announces the distribution of materials for the printing of the said learning resources.
