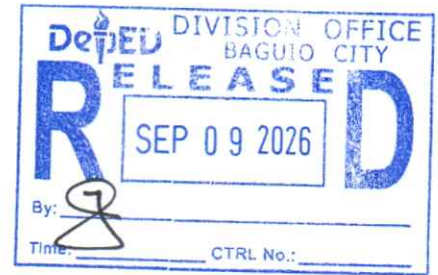

- DepEd Order No. 006, s. 2026 – Guidelines on Ensuring a Safe and Motivating Learning Environment (ESMLE).

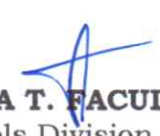

**REITERATION OF COMPLIANCE TO DEPED ORDER NO. 40, S. 2012 AND ITS
SUPPLEMENTAL GUIDELINES, REVISED IRR OF RA 10627, AND
DEPED ORDER NO. 006, S. 2026 (ESMLE)**

To: Assistant Regional Director

All Others Concerned

1. In keeping with the Department of Education's commitment to uphold the rights and welfare of all learners, and to ensure the provision of a safe and motivating learning environment, this Office hereby reiterates the provisions of DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012 or the DepEd Child Protection Policy, its supplemental guidelines, the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 10627, Otherwise Known as the "Anti-Bullying Act of 2013," and DepEd Order No. 006, s. 2026 or the Guidelines on Ensuring a Safe and Motivating Learning Environment (ESMLE).
2. All Schools Division Offices and schools are enjoined to review and ensure full and continuing compliance with the DepEd Child Protection and Anti-Bullying Policies. They shall strengthen the implementation of learner protection mechanisms and undertake appropriate preventive and response measures to address learner protection concerns and foster a culture of respect, accountability, and child protection in all learning environments.
3. To strengthen awareness and promote compliance, schools are encouraged to integrate discussions on child protection and anti-bullying policies into flag ceremonies, homeroom guidance sessions, Values Education classes, parent orientations, youth formation activities, and other school-based programs, including the observance of National Children's Month. Schools are likewise encouraged to post information materials in conspicuous areas within the school and utilize official communication channels and social media platforms to reinforce bullying prevention.
