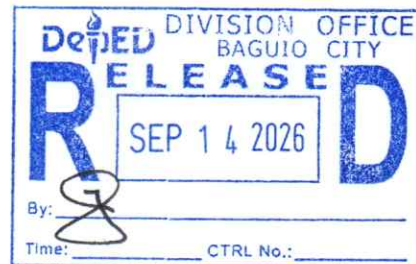

**BASIC LIFE SUPPORT AND STANDARD FIRST AID TRAINING
(BLS-SFAT) FOR SCHOOLS AND DIVISION UTILITY WORKERS**

To: All Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads
All SDO Personnel
All Others Concerned

1. In line with the Department of Education's commitment to ensuring safe, healthy, and resilient learning environments, the Schools Division of Baguio City, through the Schools Governance and Operations Division, shall conduct a Basic Life Support and Standard First Aid Training (BLS-SFAT) for Schools and Division Office Utility Workers on October 13-16, 2026 (Batch 1) and October 20-23, 2026 (Batch 2) at Plaza Garden Hotel, Europa Compound, Corner Legarda Road and Aspiras - Palispis Highway in Baguio City.

2. The activity aims to strengthen the emergency preparedness and response capacity of schools by equipping utility personnel with Basic Life Support (BLS) and Standard First Aid competencies. By building in-house first response capability, schools become safer, more responsive, and more resilient environments where immediate life-saving interventions can be administered during critical situations. Ultimately, the activity seeks to institutionalize a culture of safety and shared responsibility, ensuring that no emergency goes unattended due to lack of trained personnel.

3. In preparation for the activity, all schools are requested to assist their respective school utilities in confirming the schedule they will be attending through the following link: <https://tinyurl.com/BLS-SFAT-Util> or through the QR Code below on or before **September 23, 2026**:



4. Each batch can accommodate a maximum of 40 participants. Accordingly, participants in excess of the 40-person capacity will be automatically transferred to the succeeding batch. Conversely, if the succeeding batch has already reached its



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maximum capacity, the excess participants will be transferred to the preceding batch, subject to the available slots. The memorandum for final list of participants per batch will be released after the deadline of confirmation.
